

ORDINANCE NO. 130

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING HAZARDOUS OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES UPON CITY STREETS, ALLEYS AND PRIVATE PROPERTY, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARLISLE, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Hazardous driving or operating of a motor vehicle, truck, Tractor-trailer, or other motor propelled vehicle upon any City Street, alley, or upon any private property within the Corporate Limits of the City of Carlisle, Arkansas, is hereby defined as, and shall include the following:

1. Drag Racing or parallel driving when not in the Act of passing another vehicle under normal traffic conditions.
2. Applying power unnecessary in starting a vehicle so as to produce noise by causing wheels to spin on surface of street or alley.
3. Applying brakes improperly in slowing or stopping so as to produce noise and skidding or sliding of wheels.
4. Driving at an excessive rate of speed in business or residential area, or in making turns at intersections, in disregard of erected markers and signals.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation operating, or who permits the operation of a motor vehicle in violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance as defined in subsections 1 to 4 inclusive, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$200.00.

SECTION 3. Emergency Clause: Whereas the careless and willful operation of motor vehicles in the City constitutes a hazard, which affects the public health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance for the preservation of the public health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
